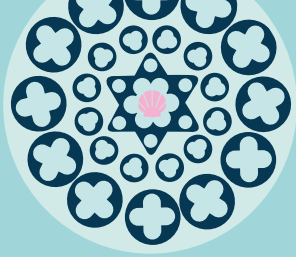
800th ANNIVERSARY OF BURGOS CATHEDRAL

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What are we CELEBRATING?

On July 21, 2021, we commemorate 800 years from the laying of the first stone of the current Burgos Cathedral. The Cathedral is the main church of a Diocese, the mother church of all its churches. It houses the Bishop's Chair, the visible place from which the Bishop of a Diocese teaches, celebrates, and tends to the Christian community.

Furthermore, the Cathedral is the natural place where people gather around their Bishop for the great feasts of the liturgical year or for diocesan meetings. It is also a witness to the faith of a Christian community that, throughout the centuries, captures the living witness of faith.

For this reason, this commemoration invites us to discover the beauty of living faith in the Diocesan Church that is the protagonist of this feast: its objective is to provoke an encounter with the Lord who comes out to meet us and sends us on our mission.

THE THEME CHOSEN IS:

“You are the temple of God”

(1 Corinthians 3,16)

We are invited to discover our own dignity and to promote the stewardship we experience as active members in the Church.

The grace of a Jubilee Year

Pope Francis has granted us the grace to live a Jubilee Year. It will be held from November 7, 2020 and will conclude on November 7, 2021 (Diocesan Church Day). Some attitudes we are invited to live during the Jubilee Year:

1. THE JUBILEE: The term jubilee expresses joy. It is the joy of a Christian community that has, in its Cathedral, the visible sign of a faith that it has inherited and which continues to grow and be nourished within that temple.

2. THANKSGIVING AND PRAYER: The Jubilee Year is a feast of thanksgiving to the God of history who has set up his tent among us and accompanied us.

3. RECONCILIATION: The Jubilee Year is especially a year of forgiveness of sins and their sorrows. The penitential dimension is expressed in the indulgence that the Church offers and that leads to conversion and the celebration of God's forgiveness. The conditions for indulgence are sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the Pope's intentions.

4. SYNODALITY: The Jubilee Year is lived especially as a Church, promoting communion and co-responsibility among all its members. The Church of Burgos lives it with a Diocesan Assembly.

5. THE SOCIAL DIMENSION OF FAITH: following the biblical tradition, the jubilee will help us to grow in our social sensitivity and in the exercise of charity and justice with the poorest and most excluded.

Jubilee RITES

The external signs that help us to visualise the interior attitude and that allow us to achieve jubilee graces are:

PILGRIMAGE TO THE CATHEDRAL: symbolises the pilgrim attitude of the believer who discovers Christ as the Way.

CROSSING THE HOLY DOOR: symbolises the attitude of leaving behind a worldly lifestyle to embrace the life that is offered to us in Christ.

THE SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATION: participation in the celebration of the sacrament of Reconciliation and the celebration of the Eucharist are fundamental moments in the celebration of the Jubilee.

PRAYER FOR THE POPE'S INTENTIONS: thus we unite ourselves to the universal Church.

ALMSGIVING: the encounter with Jesus, like Zacchaeus, leads to solidarity and mercy, especially with the poorest.

Jubilee ITINERARY

Let us suggest a small jubilee itinerary, before passing through the Holy Door, to help you prepare internally:

STEP 1: CLOISTER OF THE CATHEDRAL. *We discover the land in which the seed of faith was sown and we feel part of that history.*

STEP 2: THE SARMENTAL DOOR. *We discover Jesus Christ as our Teacher and our Way that leads us with his teaching within the Church.*

STEP 3: MAIN FAÇADE. *We discover the Virgin Mary who trusted Jesus.*

STEP 4: ENTRY THROUGH THE HOLY DOOR. *We enter through the Door that is Christ to discover the beauty of holiness.*

STEP 5: SACRAMENTAL CELEBRATION.
